RELEASE SUMMARY

The Xinet 2026.07.09 release contains fixes to resolve the following issues.

Resolved Issues

Issue	Resolution
Advanced Filename search truncated search terms longer than 18 characters, returning incorrect/extra results.	Filename search now uses the live Solr schema <code>maxGramSize</code> instead of a hardcoded 18-character limit.
Marquee Browse "Filename / Descending" sort had no effect — results stayed in ascending order.	Portal now forwards an explicit Solr sort direction for browse, with a safe default when the sort-field cookie is missing, so descending sort works correctly.
Saving an annotation comment failed on databases converted from MySQL 5.6 to 8.0, due to a broken auto-increment column.	Added a database migration that detects and repairs the broken column on upgrade.
Clicking a folder tile in the Marquee central panel was noticeably slower than navigating via the sidebar.	Folder tiles now use the same fast in-place navigation as the sidebar/breadcrumbs instead of reloading the full page.
The "Has Each" advanced search operator didn't work correctly for several field types (ICC, video, annotations, comments, etc.)	Fixed the underlying logic error so "Has Each" is correctly applied across all affected search fields.
RHEL7→RHEL9 database conversion could abort or corrupt the workspace during the MySQL 8 upgrade step.	Hardened the conversion to verify the prior upgrade step completed successfully before starting MySQL 8, and pinned to a stable MySQL 8.0.45 release.
After RHEL7→RHEL9 conversion, Portal users could not browse below their top-level volumes.	The conversion now carries over host-local permission and authentication state that was previously left behind.
Files on filesystems with large device IDs (ZFS, FUSE, network mounts) failed to sync under strict database mode, causing files to go permanently missing.	Widened the affected database columns to support 64-bit device IDs.
When Solr was offline, browse/search silently returned empty results instead of an error, and an obsolete search-engine parameter was still being sent.	Search-engine selection is now fully automatic, Solr-eligible requests fail loudly with a visible error when Solr is down, and the obsolete parameter is no longer sent.
Database-backed search returned empty results under MySQL 8's stricter default SQL mode.	Fixed the underlying query and hardened the regression test.

Notice: Samba Versioning

Xinet Samba VFS modules are built and available for the Samba feature series listed under Certified Platforms. Because Samba's VFS interface changes only between feature releases, the modules work with any maintenance release within each series. If you encounter compatibility issues with another version, please contact Customer Support.

We recommend testing these changes in a controlled environment before deploying to production systems, particularly if you have workflows that heavily utilize macOS clients or rely on metadata preservation.

Server Prerequisites

- The server must run a supported RHEL 9 and Samba version — see Certified Platforms below.
- Should have a valid RedHat subscription to download codeready packages.

The installer will download the required RHEL 9-dependent libraries and services, which require patching to work in conjunction with XINET.
